



Medicine Councillor Report — Council of September 28, 2017

This report details my activities spanning September 11 to September 24, inclusive.

SSMU Activities

I have not led any activities related to SSMU, except submitting my preferences for committees.

Committees have not resumed activities.

I have discussed the recent Board of Directors' decision regarding the constitutionality of BDS motions with some constituents.

MSS Activities

As I have not covered my summer activities in any report, I would like to note here that I attended the Canadian Medical Association's General Council and Annual General Meeting as member observer on August 20-23 in Québec City, as a member observer. I had the opportunity to discuss medical policy with students, residents and physicians from across Canada. Highlights included panels on the opioid crisis and professional autonomy, as well as discussions on pharmacare and the proposed modifications to the taxation of corporations and small businesses.

I have begun work in a leadership position for the MSS official documents strategy. This full review of all documents is expected to lead to the adoption of a simplified and shortened constitution, as well as the adoption of bylaws to regulate MSS activities such as elections and finances. The MSS hopes to have all amendments approved at the latest during the spring general assembly.

The MSS hosted the annual clubs day on September 13. I was present at the MSS table to discuss SSMU and my role with constituents.

The MSS fall election ended on September 18. Julie De Meulemeester was elected as VP Global Health, Jr.

General Council for the MSS was held on September 19. I updated Council about the SSMU Legislative Council of September 14, as well as the rolling out of the menstrual hygiene products approved by last year's referendum.
